The Chair expressed that he has been reflecting on his position within the organisation and expressed his desire to continue in the role provided he has the support of Board Members. He invited each Member to share their individual perspectives.

Two Board Members expressed concerns about the Chair's continued leadership given the current scrutiny and suggested that a change in Chair may be necessary to protect WICS' reputation and regulatory role. Three others showed support for the Chair's strength in leadership but acknowledged the difficult situation and political challenges facing the organisation, questioning whether a change in leadership would assist in moving the organisation forward.

Following the discussion, Members noted that the decision regarding the Chair's position ultimately lies with the Chair and the Scottish Government, who are responsible for the Chair's appointment. The Chair thanked Members for their feedback and agreed to reflect on the discussion and consider next steps.
