A.2.a. ISSUE OR DEFECT WHICH THIS MCCP / OCCP SEEKS TO ADDRESS
 Required under Market Code Parts 8.7.1 (ii) (b) and 8.8.1 (ii) (b)

Licensed Providers may need to take account of Non-Market Meters in calculating Customers' consumption and invoicing. Data on each Non-Market Meter is available in the LVI but is largely absent from the Market Data Set.

The only information included is in the X36 Meter Network File where they are identified as sub-meters.

Scottish Water receives a daily report of Non-Market Meters as an Additional Service. This file includes many of the details provided for Market Meters in the X33 Active and Pending Meters file. However, this file is not available to Licensed Providers.

MCCP309 improved data flows to LPs about Non-Market Meters by introducing a notification when such meters are exchanged but onboarding and invoicing Customers with a meter in a network with a Non-Market Meter remains a slow process that involves looking up initial data and ongoing changes in the LVI.

General Description

This Change Proposal would expand the Market Data Set to include 4 additional files:

- X40NonMarketMeters – active and pending Non-Market Meters
- X41NMMREADS – meter reads for active and pending Non-Market Meters
- X42SwapDiscNMM – swapped and discontinued Non-Market Meters
- X43SwapDiscNMMReads – meter reads for swapped and discontinued Non-Market Meters

These files would provide LPs with data needed to set up invoicing and generate accurate bills for Customers.

The content would be similar to the content of the X33, X35, X38 and X39 files respectively. However, the X40 and X42 files would not include address details for the Non-Market Meters. These details are not needed for billing and could include information that would allow calculation of water usage by identifiable individuals or households. Good data management practice would suggest not sharing data that is not necessary for market operations.

UR 3 File publication. The files set out in UR 1 shall be published alongside the existing MDS files each day.

UR 4 Initial file set. The initial file set generated after deployment shall include all historic non-household meters and their reads.
