

## Notice of the Commission's Decision on the Extension of the Wholesale Charges Deferral Scheme and Deferral of Prepayment of Wholesale Charges

## September 2020

The Commission published COVID-19 Response and Decision on Measures in Support of Nonhousehold Customers in May 2020. To ensure that customers affected by the COVID-19 pandemic were appropriately protected the Commission noted in its <u>decision</u> that it would review the scheme and decide whether it would be appropriate to extend the end date of the scheme from September 2020 to December 2020.

In reviewing the scheme, the Commission sought further information from licenced providers on the operation of the scheme and invited market participants to provide their views on the functioning of the scheme. The Commission wrote to stakeholders on 21 August 2020 to consult on its proposed approach to extend the scheme and postpone the introduction of the wholesale prepayment requirement. The Commission received responses from seven Licensed Providers and Citizens Advice Scotland and would like to thank all stakeholders for their comments. All respondents have expressed their support for the Commission's proposed approach.

The Commission believes that is important to provide certainty to businesses during these challenging times and take appropriate steps to preserve the operation and integrity of the market. In light if this and considering the imminent unwinding of other government support measures to businesses, the Commission has decided to extend the end date of the Wholesale Charges Deferral Scheme from 24 September 2020 to 31 December 2020.

The Commission has also decided to extend the temporary suspension of the prepayment terms of wholesale charges by licensed providers to Scottish Water, which was set out in its decision published in May 2020. This moves the step to prepay one month's wholesale charges in advance, which was planned to be reintroduced from October 2020, to February 2021 with two months in advance prepayment of wholesale charges being reintroduced from May 2021.

The table below sets out the updated timetable:
